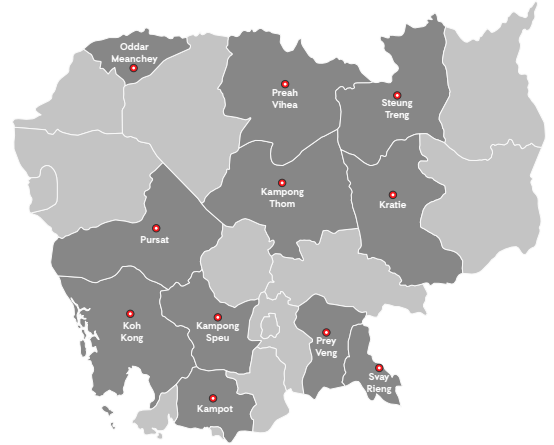


ActionAid Cambodia in Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Adaptation Work

ACTIONAID CAMBODIA'S WORK ON DRR/CCA

ActionAid Cambodia works in partnership with communities, civil society organizations, networks and local government to strengthen the disaster risk reduction (DRR) and climate change adaptation (CCA) capacity at the local and national level to reduce the disaster risk impact on the livelihood of vulnerable communities in **11** target provinces in Cambodia. ActionAid Cambodia focus programme intervention on the establishing resilience community, policy advocacy, multi-hazard anticipatory actions and emergency response.

MULTI-HAZARD ANTICIPATORY ACTION

ActionAid Cambodia in collaboration with National, and Sub-National Committee for Disaster Management (NCDM) to advancing an effective and well-functioning early warning system in the country for community people who live in the disaster-prone area.

- 06 Surface Water Level Monitoring sensors
- 01 Mobile Application for Early Warning System
- 71 71 NCDM and MRD officials equipped with disaster management and water source management capacity
- 151 CSOs and Government Officials engaged in DRR actions

EMERGENCY RESPONSE

ActionAid Cambodia also works in collaboration with local partners and the woman champions to respond to 2,667 Families affected by natural disasters such as floods and droughts.

- 1,052 Families affected by flood and strong wind (2023)
- 1,615 Families affected by drought (2024)
