Role Overview:	The Climate Change & Resilient Livelihood Specialist is responsible for leading the design, coordination, and implementation of AAC's programme and projects linked to AAC's programme priority on Resilience Building including Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR), Climate Change (CC), and resilient livelihoods. The CCRLS work in close collaboration with programme teams, consortium partners, and relevant stakeholders. The role ensures alignment with organizational standards and donor compliance requirements, contributing to the integration of resilience building and DRR/CC approaches within ActionAid Cambodia's Local Rights Programme (LRP) and strategic priorities. This position will provide technical leadership and manage thematic programme and project delivery, including emergency response interventions, fostering strategic partnerships with government agencies, civil society organizations, and communities. It will ensure effective coordination, high-quality documentation, and achievement of results across project areas. The role will also represent ActionAid Cambodia in national and international forums, enhancing visibility and advocacy on climate

Ensure overall financial control and sound management of project budgets, including monitoring expenditure and financial performance across ActionAid Cambodia and consortium partners. Oversee adherence to all contractual and donor-specific financial **Budget and** requirements, including general conditions, procurement, and visibility Monitoring guidelines. Facilitate external financial audits in accordance with agreed Terms of Reference and ensure timely follow-up on audit recommendations. Work closely with ActionAid Cambodia's Finance team, implementing partners, consortium members, and where applicable, ActionAid UK and donors, to ensure timely fund disbursement, accurate reporting, and regular financial review meetings. Facilitate regular coordination meetings with the DRR/CC team and across departments to promote cross-organisational learning, collaboration, and effective project management. Represent ActionAid Cambodia and the consortium in strategic forums including government agencies, the Joint Action Group (JAG), Humanitarian Response Forum (HRF), and international humanitarian Representation, platforms to build alliances and influence DRR/CC policies and Advocacy and practices. **Networking** Oversee project-related communications and visibility efforts across AAC platforms (website, social media), ActionAid federation channels, and external media, in coordination with campaign, fundraising, and communications teams. Develop and maintain effective partnerships with consortium members, government ministries (e.g. NCDM, MoE, MAFF), donors, and LRP partners to align efforts, share learning, and ensure policy engagement and project alignment with national frameworks. Provide evidence-based input and case stories from project implementation to advocacy initiatives, contributing regularly to JAG and HRF efforts while promoting AAC's Resilient livelihood, DRR/CC profile nationally and sub-nationally. Assess technical and project management capacities of LRPs, implementing partners, and AAC teams, identifying gaps and coordinating tailored capacity-building actions with the Programme & Capacity building & Business Development Lead. **Technical Support** Lead the integration of Resilient Livelihood, DRR, CCA, and sustainable water management into AAC's core programmes, focusing on climate-resilient agriculture, natural resource management, and education. Facilitate reflection sessions and shared learning platforms to capture lessons learned on resilience and livelihood outcomes, and ensure the alignment of M&E systems across DRR/CCA initiatives. Assist in developing concept notes and proposals for DRR, CCA, and emergency response in alignment with AAC's strategic goals and CSP priorities. Ensure preparedness of community organizations. organizations, and local governments for effective humanitarian response, strengthening resilience and promoting sustainable livelihoods.
